1. Where does the name "Jasper" come from?

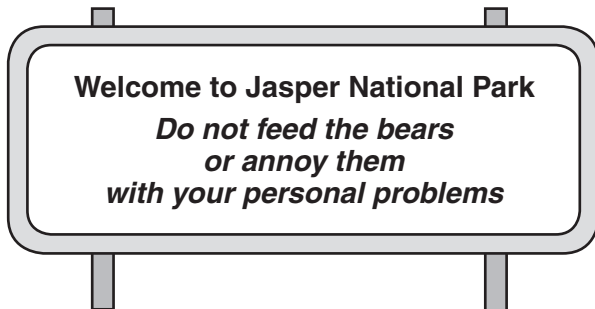
- From Jasper the Bear, of course.
